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Barney's opened mid September as an alternative to the large fast food chains along the Hume Highway offering exceptional coffee and an array of tempting dishes from a hearty Barney's burger, a mouthwatering marinated scotch fillet steak sandwich, to light summer salads and sandwiches. The choice of Barney's homemade pies is expanding with the basic meat version available to the more exotic such as the Northern Territory Water Buffalo as well as the Lamb and Shiraz.

Breakfast at Barney's is becoming an institution with perfectly cooked poached (or fried) eggs on a bed of spinach with roasted tomato and bacon. The eggs benedict is exceptional and George and fellow chef Allan Smith have no problem in whipping up feather light omelettes or scrambled eggs and at weekends their pancakes fly off the plate. Barney's is also becoming famous for the range of truly tempting cakes such as blueberry swirl cheesecake and fig and pecan pie.

George saw the opportunity to take on the challenge of opening a café/diner on the Highway halfway through building it. A man of many talents, he is well known as a designer/builder and since leaving Wagga eight years ago he has been busy on a number of projects including building and opening a cottage gallery at Binalong, which is run by his wife Liz Knight and her brother, Joseph Corkhill. Corkhills Art of Living at 56 Stephens St Binalong is a treasure chest of antiques, jewellery and art set in an abundant garden created by Joseph, a renowned regional landscape designer.
